<b>ITEM 6:</b>	<b>FSOC Briefing to CBFWA Members</b> The CBFWA Members have asked for an update from each of the technical committees at their bi-annual meetings. Lynn Stratton and Dave Ward will provide this briefing at the Members meeting scheduled for August 24 <sup>th</sup> in Couer D' Alene. The briefing will include a summary of past-year's activities and expected activities for the upcoming year.

<b>ITEM 7:</b>	<b>Future FSOC Direction</b> During the April 28 <sup>th</sup> teleconference, the FSOC began to discuss potential future priorities. Some items discussed included continued involvement with horizontal screens, periodic review of all screen criteria, screening needs and criteria for lamprey, non-anadromous screening, conflicts between upstream and downstream criteria, entrainment, and education and outreach. The FSOC decided to discuss items in more detail at future meetings.
<b>ITEM 8:</b>	<b>Next FSOC Teleconference</b> The next FSOC meeting will be in Cle Elum on September 13.
